



EUSA Level 2 Coaching Courses Notes on TD Analysis Requirement – 2010 Project

- 1. Course participants in each L2 Coaching Course are required to research, analyse and then prepare their individual analysis of a number of Touchdowns that are included on the TFA resource package "100TD for Coaches of the Game".
- 2. Participants should receive a copy of the package NLT one week prior to commencement of the L2 workshop.
- 3. Each participant should prepare a 5-10 minutes presentation on each of the allocated TD from within that allocated group and be prepared to discuss the "cause and effect" of technical details (from the individual, sub-unit and team perspectives) for each of those the TD from both the ATTACKING and DEFENDING teams.
- 4. During the workshop delivery, each participant will be required to deliver their analysis on a minimum of 2 of the allocated TD. The selection will be based on one of the TD being nominated by the participant as a preferred analysis and the second TD being randomly decided by participant peers during the workshop.
- 5. Participants may anticipate availability of laptop, projector, screen, whiteboard and a pointing device to assist with their presentations.
- 6. Assessment of the detail of the analysis will be a factor in the overall assessment of a participant's performance at the L2 workshop.
- 7. Participants may discuss TD with other participants prior to the workshop.
